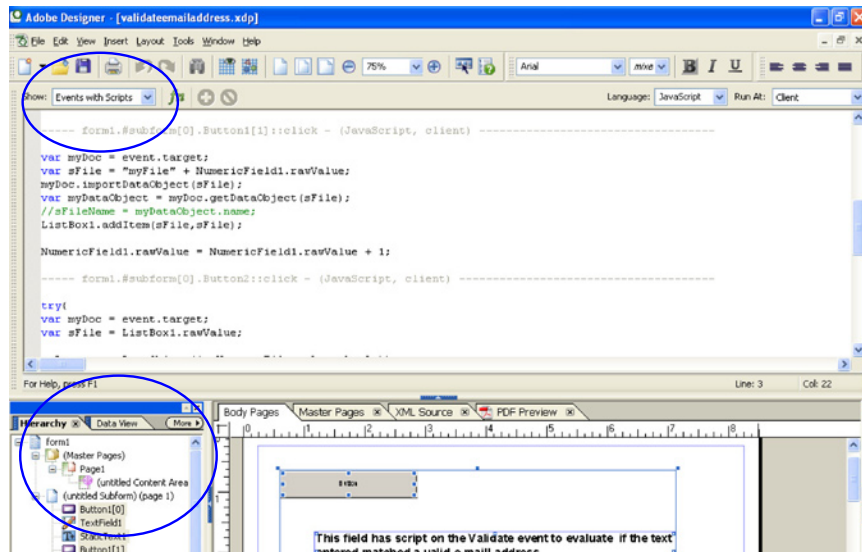
Viewing all scripts in a template

Use this tip to view all scripts in a template.

1. In the Scripting Editor window, select Events with Scripts from the Show menu.
2. If you have a one-page template, use Control+A to select all objects on the page. Otherwise, click the top item in the Hierarchy palette and then shift-click the bottom item to select all objects in the range.

All scripts appear in the Scripting Editor window.
